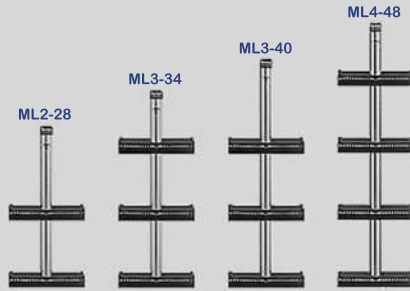

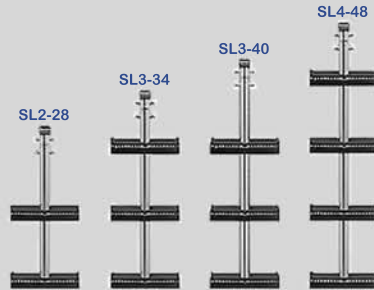

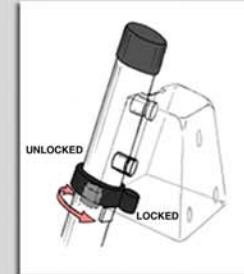
Original Center Pole Marine Ladder - ML
